GUIDELINES FOR THE SEARCH FOR THE TEN (10) EXCEPTIONAL BRAVERY AT SEA AWARDEES

INTRODUCTION

In line with the celebration of the Day of the Seafarer on 25 June 2020 with the theme *#SeafarersAreKeyWorkers*, the Maritime Industry Authority, adopting the same IMO invitation for nomination, is launching the online search for **ten (10) Exceptional Bravery at Sea Awardees** (Domestic/International).

PURPOSE AND CRITERIA

The purpose of the Award is to provide recognition to those who, at the risk of losing their own life, performed acts of exceptional bravery, displaying outstanding courage in attempting to save life at sea or in attempting to prevent or mitigate damage to the marine environment. Such acts of bravery may also involve extraordinary seaman ship skills in very difficult conditions or any other display of outstanding courage. Except in the most extraordinary circumstances, the nominated rescues should occur at sea or those rescued should emanate from a vessel. The Award may also be granted posthumously.

The following criteria for the nominated awardee are:

- a. Must be an active seafarer at the time of the incident. Potential awardees may not necessarily be an active commercial seafarer but at the time of the action is an active seafarer and may be now engaged in the maritime industry: *from the academe, training or assessment centers, manning/shipping/crewing companies, non-governmental organizations, maritime associations and even in civil service.*
- b. The exceptional bravery has been proven to have saved life/lives and/or prevented damage to his/her vessel, cargo/property or the marine environment
- c. Endorser/s must be able to provide documentations to prove that the exceptional bravery was indeed performed in the course of his/her duty.

NOMINATIONS

Nominations for the Award may be made by Licensed Manning Agencies, Shipping Companies, Intergovernmental Organizations and/or Non-governmental Maritime Organizations or any other legitimate endorsers and the like via pid_stcw@marina.gov.ph, (with **Subject: Nomination for Exceptional Bravery at Sea Awardee 2020**), using the attached Nomination Form together with the Description of Events/Circumstances, **not later than 12NN, 15 August 2020.**



It should provide a full description of the circumstances and events giving rise to the nomination. They should, as appropriate, include such factors as: .1 location of the incident; .2 prevailing weather conditions; .3 skill displayed; .4 leadership demonstrated; .5 determination to conduct the rescue operation; .6 exceptional courage demonstrated; .7 degree of risk (to human lives and/or the marine environment) involved; as well as .8 any other information supporting the nomination.

It should be noted that nomination received after the deadline has expired will not be eligible for consideration.

FORM OF THE AWARD

The award will take the form of medal or plaque, which will be accompanied by a certificate citing the act of exceptional bravery performed.

ASSESSMENT PANEL

The Assessment Panel shall be composed of the Overall Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the Chairmen of the different MARINA Committees of the Day of the Seafarer 2020. Their function will be to review the nominations for the Award, taking into account the Award's purpose and criteria vis-à-vis the description of the factual circumstances giving rise to the nomination and the related supporting documentation. The Panel will submit to a Panel of Judges a shortlist ranking the nominees in order of preference, along with the rationale for their recommendation.

PANEL OF JUDGES

A panel of judges composed of the MARINA Administrator, STCW Executive Director, the STCW Deputy Executive Director or their Officers-in-Charge, the Director of the MARINA Maritime Safety Service and the Over-all Chairman of the MARINA Committee for the Maritime Week Celebration 2020

No Award will be made in the event that the Panel of Judges decides that the acts performed by the shortlisted nominees do not merit the Award. The Administrator will be invited to endorse the outcome of the Panel of Judges.

AWARD CEREMONY

The MARINA Administrator will present the Award for "Exceptional Bravery at Sea" during the 2020 National Maritime Week Celebration.
