TRAINING INSTITUTIONS

The Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) strongly advises all Filipino seafarers and the general public to exercise due diligence and caution in selecting maritime training institutions (MTI). Recent reports have revealed the proliferation of unauthorized and illegal MTIs falsely claiming to offer legitimate maritime training services. These entities are neither accredited nor recognized by MARINA, and engaging with such providers poses significant risks to your professional qualifications and financial resources.

To safeguard your interests and ensure that you receive quality and MARINA-accredited training, we strongly encourage you to verify the legitimacy of the MTI through MARINA's official directory which can be accessed through the following link:
