Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Presidential Decree 474, Republic Act 10635 and its Implementing Rules and Regulation, and all applicable provisions of MARINA Memorandum Circulars SC-2021-03, SC-2021-04, SC-2021-05 and SC-2021-06, effective 09 November 2021, the MARINA has issued new formats for its Certificates of Competency (COC) and Certificates of Proficiency (COP), samples of which are shown below. The said change in format was already communicated on 04 November 2021 to the International Maritime Organization (IMO) with a request that the same be likewise disseminated to All IMO Members, Intergovernmental Organizations and Non-Governmental Organizations in Consultative Status.
