Please take notice that MARINA STCW Circular No. 2018 - 09 on the Revised Rules and Mandatory Minimum Requirements in the Assessment of Competence of Seafarers under the relevant provisions of Chapters III of the STCW Convention, 1978, as amended, which was posted in STCW Website is hereby rectified to reflect the correct provisions, as follows:

MARINA STCW CIRCULAR NO. 2018 - 09

"Article V SPECIFIC PROVISIONS

c) x x x

- i. A candidate who fails in a specific function shall only be allowed to take a remedial assessment after **one (1) month** but not to exceed one (1) year from the date of the initial examination.

- iii. A candidate who fails the remedial assessment, shall only be allowed to take a removal assessment after **one (1) month**, but not to exceed one (1) year from the date of the remedial assessment.

c) x x x

- i. A candidate who fails in a specific scenario shall only be allowed to take a remedial assessment after **one (1) month**, but not to exceed one (1) year from the date of the initial practical assessment;

- iii. A candidate who fails the remedial assessment shall only be allowed to take removal assessment after **one (1) month** but not to exceed one (1) year from the date of the remedial assessment;
